

YHA Snowdon Llanberis - Access Statement

Introduction

If you're tackling Yr Wyddfa (Snowdon), the Llanberis path starts near to this great Eryri (Snowdonia) accommodation. Mountain bikers, climbers and walkers are spoilt for choice at this picturesque hostel. It's also close to Blue Flag beaches on the Welsh coast – ideal for school trips, family holidays or just a weekend getaway!

This three-storey building is located on the lower slopes of Yr Wyddfa (Snowdon) in a semi-rural location just outside the village of Llanberis. Unfortunately, none of our bedrooms or bathrooms meet modern standards of accessibility.

Pre-arrival

- The nearest rail station is Bangor, 12 miles away.
- The nearest bus stop is 0.5 miles away. Limited bus services run to this stop.
- A local taxi company can provide accessible taxis when pre-booked.
- The hostel is approximately 0.5 miles from the centre of Llanberis. The roads approaching and surrounding the hostel can be narrow and are surfaced with tarmac. There are sections which are steep and there are no pavements or streetlights. From the road there is a short tarmac drive of approximately 60m to the main entrance.

Car parking and arrival

We have plenty of on-site parking located behind the building within 20m of the entrance. There are no marked bays and parking is on a first-come-first-serve basis. If you have a specific access need, please contact the hostel before your stay. The car park has a slight slope and an uneven stone surface. It is well-lit by floodlights.

From here to the main entrance there is access across a loose stone path and onto the concrete forecourt. There are three well-lit steps without a handrail up into the porch. Guests can also be dropped off in front of the main entrance. If you let us know when you are coming, we'll do our best to assist with moving to and from cars.

Main entrance and reception

There is no level access to the hostel. To enter the hostel, there is another step up through manual double doors which open inwards into the entry hall and reception area. There is a wooden bench inside the front door and the closest other seating is in the dining room about 10m from the front door along a level surface. If further seating in the entrance is required, please speak to a member of staff.

The reception area is well-lit and the floor is level throughout with laminate flooring. A portable induction loop is available on request at reception. A payphone is situated on the ground floor next to the lounge, accessed from reception by going up 3 steps with a handrail and through a single leaf door. In an emergency, outside of reception hours, a member of YHA staff is contactable via the emergency payphone.

Public areas

Halls and corridors

There is good colour contrast to floors, walls and doorways throughout the building. All public areas, halls, stairs and landings are well lit using a combination of ceiling and wall lights. The upper corridors, WCs and showers have automatic lighting sensors fitted.

The corridor flooring is carpet on the ground and first floor. Due to the age of the building there are some sets of steps in the corridors of the ground and first floors.

We do not have a lift so access to the first and lower ground floors is by stairs only. Internal stairs have high visibility strips on the first and last step. The main staircase is carpeted, while the basement staircase is stone. Both have a handrail to one side.

WCs

There are two WCs on the ground floor. From reception there are 3 steps up and then through a single leaf door. Both WCs are well-lit and have non-slip flooring, though neither WC meets modern standards of accessibility.

Lounge

Our lounge is on the ground floor. There are 3 steps up and 2 single leaf doors to reach this room. Once there, the room is level throughout and has carpet flooring. It is well-lit with ceiling lights. From here there is a fire escape onto the balcony and then seven concrete steps down to the forecourt with a handrail on one side.

The lounge is furnished with coffee tables, sofas, stools and armchairs. All furniture can be moved – please ask at reception if you require assistance.

Dining room

The dining room is located on the ground floor and has level access from reception via a single leaf door. The floor is level and surfaced with laminate. It is evenly lit with ceiling lights. The furniture consists of tables, benches and stools, all of which can be moved – please ask at reception if you require assistance.

The servery is also located in this room. Table service is available – please ask at reception. We are also happy to cater for dietary requirements though ask that you please advise us of these before your arrival.

Self-catering kitchen

The self-catering kitchen is located on the ground floor and has level access from the dining room. It has level laminate flooring and good lighting.

It is fitted with:

- 2 gas ovens, each with a 4-burner hob and grill (90cm high)
- 2 microwaves, 2 kettles and 2 toasters on a work surface (90cm high)
- 2 floor-standing fridges
- 2 sinks with single mixer tap (90cm high)

Crockery and some kitchen equipment are kept in high shelving units. We are happy to move these to lower storage if required.

Laundry and drying facilities

The laundry room is located opposite reception, with level access through a single leaf door. Here there are drying rails and a washing machine available for guests to use. The floor is level and surfaced with plywood.

Meeting room or classroom

The classroom is located on the lower ground floor. There are 14 steps down to this floor and then level access through a single leaf door from here. The flooring is carpeted and the room is well-lit. We can provide tables and chairs in a variety of seating arrangements.

There is a fire door from the classroom which leads through onto a loose stone path, followed by five concrete steps with a handrail to one side up to the forecourt.

Bedrooms and bathrooms

Unless otherwise stated, all bedrooms have bunk beds and a washbasin. All rooms are carpeted and well-lit with ceiling and individual bunk lights. Bedding is provided.

All our bathrooms have fluorescent lighting and non-slip flooring. Standard showers have a step up to enter.

First floor

There are 15 steps up to this floor. In the corridors, there are two sets of 2 steps.

- Three rooms that sleep up to 2 people each. They include a set of bunk beds.
- One en-suite room that sleeps up to 3 people. It includes a single high-sleeper bunk with a double bed underneath.
- Three rooms that sleep up to 4 people each. They include 2 sets of bunk beds.
- One en-suite room that sleeps up to 5 people. It includes a single high-sleeper bunk with a double bed underneath and a set of bunk beds.

- One room that sleeps up to 5 people. It includes a single high-sleeper bunk with a double bed underneath and a set of bunk beds.
- One room that sleeps up to 5 people. It includes 2 sets of bunk beds and a single bed.
- One en-suite room that sleeps up to 6 people. It includes 3 sets of bunk beds.
- One room that sleeps up to 6 people. It includes 3 sets of bunk beds.
- · Five showers.
- Five WCs.

Grounds and garden

Next to the hostel there is a grass and former orchard area; farm fencing separates this from the surrounding countryside. Children should always be supervised when playing in the grounds.

Camping pods

There are two camping pods in the hostel grounds, accessed via a loose stone path which is on a slight uphill gradient, and then up two large steps with no handrail. There is a step up on to decked patio for each pod. The path to the pods is not well lit and a torch may be needed after dark.

Both camping pods contain 2 single beds and a double mattress on the floor, with all bedding provided. The pods have electric underfloor heating and electric lights.

There is a toilet and shower located from the camping pods down two large steps and a loose stone path with a slight downhill gradient. The path is not well-lit so a torch may be needed after dark. To access the toilet/shower room there is a step and a single leaf door to a carpeted foyer area. Then there is level access through another single leaf door to the toilet and shower. This bathroom is well-lit with fluorescent lighting and non-slip flooring. The shower has a step up to enter.

Additional information

- The building is accessible out-of-hours to pre-booked guests via an access code, which is changed daily.
- Luggage transfers can be arranged for pre-booked groups.
- Pets are not permitted at YHA Snowdown Llanberis, except in our Camping & Cabins accommodation or when hiring the whole hostel through Exclusive Hire. Assistance dogs are welcome – please notify us at the time of booking.
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the hostel.
- A member of staff is available on-site during reception opening hours from 8am to 10am and 5pm to 10pm. If no staff are on-site, YHA staff can be contacted in an emergency via the emergency phone at reception.
- Emergency lighting and fire alarms are fitted. Our teams won't fetch you in the event of a fire or similar emergency. If the alarms go off, evacuate the building through the nearest exit (do not wait for a member of staff). Arrangements for guests needing assistance to evacuate should be discussed at check-in.
- Evacuation procedures are displayed in each bedroom.

- Mobile phone reception within the hostel is good.
- Wi-Fi is available in the lounge.
